

# Response to Redundancy

## A training initiative that helps people to find rewarding new work



Response to Redundancy is a programme which offers advice, guidance and re-training opportunities to help people train for new careers after redundancy.

It gives early support to certify existing skills and provide appropriate training to improve opportunities in the job market for when workers leave their current occupation.

To access the training each employee has an Information and Advice session with an accredited adviser to:

- Assess the current skills of the individual.
- Discuss the desired direction of the individual's career.
- Discuss training options to improve existing skills or change career direction.

If your one-to-one Information and Advice session identifies training to help improve your job prospects, Response to Redundancy can offer funding to support the training.

Some people take redundancy as an opportunity to reassess their careers and go into self-employment. If this is the case the broker can also signpost training that can help candidates start their own business.

Response to Redundancy also provides training workshops to assist with 'soft skills' such as CV preparation, job search and interview techniques.
